Legislative Robert DelSordo spoke about "Move Over" Law being modified

Tax payer money is being spent on about 100 prison inmates seeking gender re-assignment drugs. There is proposal to repeal any tax on all baby items making them tax free.

The Governor wanted to raise the sales tax back to 7% which the Assembly speaker has refused to do; but to make up for that they agreed to raise corporate taxes which will inevitably be passed on the consumers.

And "OPRA" law was amended making it easier for local municipal clerks and others to get extensions and make it a bit harder for Lawyer and citizen requests to be completed

Pension Board Ken Buck Excused but sent a text to Delegate Bill Seamen Local 12 and an extremely long discussion was held Highlights as follows

- 1 Union officials are giving their active members mis-information saying they won't get raises if retirees get "COLA"
- 2 The Governor nor the legislature have any interest or influence on "COLA"
- 3 The Retirees are being unfairly represented on the pension board by only having 1 Representative
- 4 "COLA" is solely in the hands of the Pension Board and covered by Chapter 55 and the "PAA"
