Legislative Report

Bob DeSordo reports that a new DUI law will allow people adjudicated to have been driving while intoxicated to drive to work, so long as they have a breathalyzer interlock on their vehicle. Such an device will be paid for by the offender and there is some doubt as to how difficult it will be to circumvent.

The legislature is considering the creation of retired badges for police and firemen. The body unanimously supported the proposal (16/8) and locals are encouraged to contact their local legislators to enact the measure.
